

## GOSPEL LK 19:1-10

At that time, Jesus came to Jericho and intended to pass through the town. Now a man there named Zacchaeus, who was a chief tax collector and also a wealthy man, was seeking to see who Jesus was; but he could not see him because of the crowd, for he was short in stature. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree in order to see Jesus, who was about to pass that way. When he reached the place, Jesus looked up and said, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." And he came down quickly and received him with joy. When they all saw this, they began to grumble, saying, "He has gone to stay at the house of a sinner." But Zacchaeus stood



there and said to the Lord, "Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I shall give to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times over." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house because this man too is a descendant of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost."

## UPCOMING FEAST DAY

All Saints Day is celebrated on the first of November, having a vigil and an octave. An octave means it is celebrated still seven days after. The word "Saint" means "holy one" and this feast is to honor all the saints, known and unknown, and, according to Urban IV, to supply any deficiencies in the faithful's celebration of saints' feasts during the year. At first only martyrs and St. John the Baptist were honored by a special day. Other saints were added gradually, and increased in number when a regular process of canonization was established. Gregory III (731-741) consecrated a chapel in the basilica of St. Peter to all the saints and fixed the anniversary for November 1. Gregory IV (827-844) extended the celebration on November 1 to the entire Church. The vigil seems to have been held as early as the feast itself. The octave was added by Sixtus IV (1471-84). El día de Todos los Santos se celebra el primero de noviembre, teniendo una vigilia y una octava. Una octava significa que se celebra aún siete días después. La palabra "Santo" significa "santo" y esta fiesta es para honrar a todos los santos, conocidos y desconocidos, y, según Urbano IV, para suplir las deficiencias en la celebración de las fiestas de los santos por parte de los fieles durante el año. Al principio solo los mártires y San Juan Bautista fueron honrados con un día especial. Otros santos se agregaron gradualmente y aumentaron en número cuando se estableció un proceso regular de canonización. Gregorio III (731-741) consagró una capilla en la basílica de San Pedro a todos los santos y fijó el aniversario para el 1 de noviembre. Gregorio IV (827-844) extendió la celebración del 1 de noviembre a toda la Iglesia. La vigilia parece haber tenido lugar desde la misma fiesta. La octava fue añadida por Sixto IV (1471-84).
