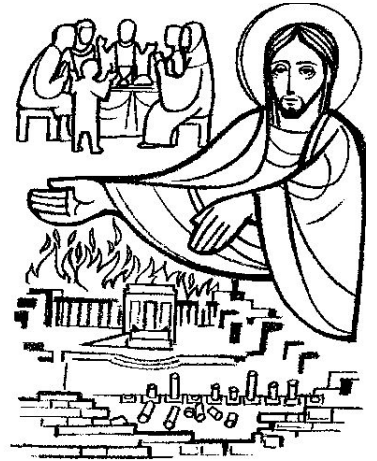

GOSPEL LK 21:5-19

While some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings, Jesus said, "All that you see here the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down." Then they asked him, "Teacher, when will this happen? And what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen?" He answered, "See that you not be deceived, for many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he,' and 'The time has come.' Do not follow them! When you hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified; for such things must happen first, but it will not immediately be the end." Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues from place to place; and awesome sights and mighty signs will come from the sky.

"Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you, they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons, and they will have you led before kings and governors because of my name. It will lead to your giving testimony. Remember, you are not to prepare your defense beforehand, for I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute. You will even be handed over by parents, brothers, relatives, and friends, and they will put some of you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."



SAINT OF THE WEEK -SAINT ELIZABETH OF HUNGARY

Elizabeth of Hungary was born July 7th, 1207 to King Andrew II of Hungary and Queen Gertrude. Despite being born into a life of privilege and luxury, Elizabeth devoted herself to a humble life and used her resources to serve the poor and sick. She would dress in simple garments, gave bread to hundreds, cared for, and founded a hospital in Marburg, Germany using her dowry. Her life of prayer and service was assisted by a Franciscan Friar who provided her spiritual direction. Elizabeth is a role model of what Christian charity looks like and the miracles following her death in 1231 lead to her canonization on May 25th, 1235. She died at the age of 24 and is the patron saint of hospitals, nurses, Catholic charities, and the Secular Franciscan Order.



Isabel de Hungría nació el 7 de julio de 1207 del rey Andrés II de Hungría y la reina Gertrudis. A pesar de haber nacido en una vida de privilegios y lujos, Isabel se dedicó a una vida humilde y utilizó sus recursos para servir a los pobres y enfermos. Se vestía con prendas sencillas, daba pan a cientos, cuidaba y fundaba un hospital en Marburg, Alemania, con su dote. Su vida de oración y servicio fue asistida por un fraile franciscano que le proporcionó dirección espiritual. Isabel es un modelo a seguir de cómo se ve la caridad cristiana y los milagros que siguieron a su muerte en 1231 la llevaron a su canonización el 25 de mayo de 1235. Murió a la edad de 24 años y es la santa patrona de hospitales, enfermeras, organizaciones benéficas católicas y la Orden Franciscana Seglar.

DONATE TO WORLD YOUTH DAY



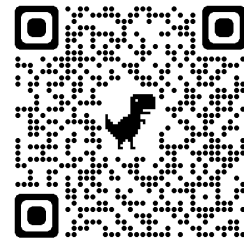
