GOSPEL: MT 5:1-12A

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain, and after he had sat down, his disciples came to him. Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven."



SAINT THOMAS AQUINAS

Saint Thomas Aquinas was born near Naples, Italy in 1225 to an influential family and was the youngest of nine children. At 16, he enrolled in the University of Naples to pursue studies in Liberal Arts and there he joined a religious order called The Order of Dominicans. Aquinas continued his studies of theology in Paris and Cologne for 11 years. In 1256, he was credited as a theologian and began teaching in universities and convents across Europe. He also encountered Christ and was later canonized as a saint in 1323 for his devotion to learning and sanctity. Aquinas left an intellectual footprint and his wisdom recorded in his philosophical and theological works influenced the Catholic Church. As a doctor of the church, we pray to Saint Thomas Aquinas for intercession. He is the patron saint of education, chastity, and students. Students, pray to him for help in your studies and for an enriching and good experience in school.



A Student's Prayer



Santo Tomás de Aquino nació cerca de Nápoles, Italia en 1225 en el seno de una familia influyente y era el menor de nueve hijos. A los 16 años se matriculó en la Universidad de Nápoles para cursar estudios de Artes Liberales y allí ingresó en una orden religiosa llamada La Orden de los Dominicos. Tomás de Aquino continuó sus estudios de teología en París y Colonia durante 11 años. En 1256, fue acreditado como teólogo y comenzó a enseñar en universidades y conventos de toda Europa. También se encontró con Cristo y más tarde fue canonizado como santo en 1323 por su devoción al aprendizaje y la santidad. Tomás de Aquino dejó una huella intelectual y su sabiduría registrada en sus obras filosóficas y teológicas influyó en la Iglesia Católica. Como doctor de la iglesia, oramos a Santo Tomás de Aquino por intercesión. Es el patrón de la educación, la castidad y los estudiantes. Estudiantes, oren a él por ayuda en sus estudios y por una experiencia enriquecedora y buena en la escuela.




