This Sunday marks the fourth Sunday in Lent and in the Gospel we are introduced to the man blind since birth. This story illustrates Jesus' mercy and power while simultaneously describing the fruitfulness of obedience and cleansing. Scripture shows us the extent to which the blind man put trust in Jesus despite criticism from society. Jesus first anointed him with mud and then instructed the blind man to wash. Jesus could have been any complete stranger and yet the blind man obeyed his every word. The acts the blind man completed also represent the sacrament of Baptism. Baptism is the cleansing of original sin and on Easter individuals of The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) will for the first time be baptized into the Catholic Church. As we can see, the Gospel mirrors what candidates for baptism experience. Some of the goals of baptism are to enlighten the soul and convert the heart closer to our Lord the same way the man born blind chose to convert and worship Jesus. The water in the Gospel and used in Baptism is a symbol of purification. This season of Lent is also a time for purification as we partake in practices such as abstaining from meat and giving alms. These acts of purification are selfless since our sights are set on cleansing our bodies and souls for Christ's ultimate gift. Let us use the blind man as a role model for how we should continue on our Lenten journeys and remember that if a blind man could put his trust in what he could not see, then why not us?

Este domingo marca el cuarto domingo de Cuaresma y en el Evangelio se nos presenta al hombre ciego de nacimiento. Esta historia ilustra la misericordia y el poder de Jesús al mismo tiempo que describe la fecundidad de la obediencia y la limpieza. La Escritura nos muestra hasta qué punto el ciego puso su confianza en Jesús a pesar de las críticas de la sociedad. Jesús primero lo ungió con barro y luego le ordenó al ciego que se lavara. Jesús podría haber sido cualquier completo extraño y, sin embargo, el ciego obedeció cada una de sus palabras. Los actos que completó el ciego también representan el sacramento del Bautismo. El bautismo es la limpieza del pecado original y en Semana Santa las personas del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos (RICA) serán bautizadas por primera vez en la Iglesia Católica. Como podemos ver, el Evangelio refleja lo que experimentan los candidatos al bautismo. Algunas de las metas del bautismo son iluminar el alma y convertir el corazón más cerca de nuestro Señor de la misma manera que el ciego de nacimiento eligió convertirse y adorar a Jesús. El agua en el Evangelio y utilizada en el Bautismo es un símbolo de purificación. Esta temporada de Cuaresma es también un tiempo de purificación al participar en prácticas tales como abstenernos de comer carne y dar limosnas. Estos actos de purificación son desinteresados ya que nuestra mirada está puesta en limpiar nuestros cuerpos y almas para el regalo supremo de Cristo. Usemos al ciego como modelo a seguir de cómo debemos continuar en nuestros viajes de Cuaresma y recordemos que si un ciego podía confiar en lo que no podía ver, ¿por qué no nosotros?

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SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Joseph is the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and plays a pivotal role in the story of Jesus. He symbolizes the protector and leader of the holy family and is the patron saint for fathers, those seeking work, workers, those seeking a holy death, and much more. He put his faith in the Lord by taking Mary, a pregnant virgin at the time, as his wife and later leading them both on a journey in preparation for the birth of their son. Seek the intercession of Saint Joseph through this prayer:

To you, O blessed Joseph, do we come in our tribulation, and having implored the help of your most holy Spouse, we confidently invoke your patronage also. Through that charity which bound you to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God and through the paternal love with which you embraced the Child Jesus, we humbly beg you graciously to regard the inheritance which Jesus Christ has purchased by his Blood, and with your power and strength to aid us in our necessities. O most watchful guardian of the Holy Family, defend the chosen children of Jesus Christ; O most loving father, ward off from us every contagion of error and corrupting influence; O our most mighty protector, be kind to us and from heaven assist us in our struggle with the power of darkness. As once you rescued the Child Jesus from deadly peril, so now protect God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity; shield, too, each one of us by your constant protection, so that, supported by your example and your aid, we may be able to live piously, to die in holiness, and to obtain eternal happiness in heaven.

GOSPEL: JN 9:1, 6-9, 13-17, 34-38

As Jesus passed by he saw a man blind from birth. He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva, and smeared the clay on his eyes, and said to him, "Go wash in the Pool of Siloam" — which means Sent —. So he went and washed, and came back able to see. His neighbors and those who had seen him earlier as a beggar said, "Isn't this the one who used to sit and beg?" Some said, "It is," but others said, "No, he just looks like him." He said, "I am." They brought the one who was once blind to the Pharisees. Now Jesus had made clay and opened his eyes on a sabbath. So then the Pharisees also asked him how he was able to see. He said to them, "He put clay on my eyes, and I washed, and now I can see." So some of the Pharisees said, "This man is not from God, because he does not keep the sabbath." But others said, "How can a sinful man do such signs?" And there was a division among them. So they said to the blind man again, "What do you have to say about him, since he opened your eyes?" He said, "He is a prophet." They answered and said to him, "You were born totally in sin, and are you trying to teach us?" Then they threw him out. When Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, he found him and said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" He answered and said, "Who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?" Jesus said to him, "You have seen him, and the one speaking with you is he." He said, "I do believe, Lord," and he worshiped him.
