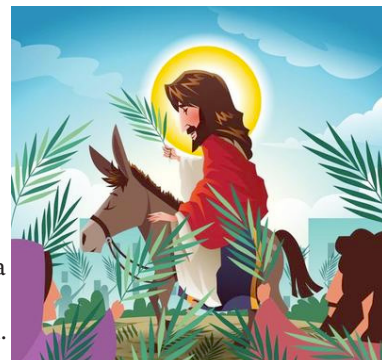

This Sunday we celebrate Palm Sunday as it marks the beginning of the final week in Lent and the passion of our Lord. Jerusalem welcomed Jesus and his disciples with crowds cheering his triumphant entry into the holy city. Our Lord entered humbly on a donkey as palms envelop his procession and people shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest." The crowds recognized Jesus as the Messiah — the savior of mankind they had been waiting for as told by the prophets. Holy Week has begun meaning this is the last week Jesus had on earth and in the Last Supper we read about his attempt to prepare his disciples for his arrest and persecution. While Jesus' passion is an event of great sorrow, it's a reminder of his love for us. Standing before Pontius Pilate, he gave himself in place of Barabbas a "notorious prisoner". Jesus paid the ultimate price and that is why throughout this season we have chosen to abstain from pleasures or give alms as a form of honoring his passion. Let us continue our Lenten promises and transform our hearts evermore so that we may rejoice on resurrection day!

Este domingo celebramos el Domingo de Ramos ya que marca el comienzo de la última semana de Cuaresma y la pasión de nuestro Señor. Jerusalén recibió a Jesús y sus discípulos con multitudes vitoreando su entrada triunfal en la ciudad santa. Nuestro señor entró humildemente en un burro mientras las palmas envolvían su procesión y la gente gritaba: "¡Hosanna al Hijo de David; bendito el que viene en el nombre del Señor; Hosanna en lo más alto." Las multitudes reconocieron a Jesús como el Mesías, el salvador de la humanidad que habían estado esperando según lo dicho por los profetas. La Semana Santa ha comenzado, lo que significa que esta es la última semana que Jesús tuvo en la tierra y en la Última Cena leemos sobre su intento de preparar a sus discípulos para su arresto y persecución. Si bien la pasión de Jesús es un evento de gran dolor, es un recordatorio de su amor por nosotros. De pie ante Poncio Pilato, se entregó en lugar de Barrabás como un "prisionero notorio". Jesús pagó el precio final y por eso a lo largo de este tiempo hemos optado por abstenernos de los placeres o dar limosna como una forma de honrar su pasión. ¡Continuemos nuestras promesas de Cuaresma y transformemos nuestros corazones cada vez más para que podamos regocijarnos en el día de la resurrección!

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Catherine of Siena was born a twin on March 25, 1347, in Siena, Italy. From an early age, Catherine had a very pious spirit, would pray constantly, and even showed her friends how to worship God. At the age of five or six, she had her first vision of Christ as he was dressed in bishops' robes alongside Saint Peter, Paul, and John. Since then she began praying intensely with a schedule and developed a closer union with Christ. Her family was supportive of her devotion but at the age of 13, her parents made arrangements to find suitors despite her personal vow of



chastity to God. God's plan would overcome her parents as Catherine joined the Third Order of Saint Dominic in the Roman

Catholic Church. She vowed to Jesus as her bridegroom and led a life of servitude to God by attending to the poor and sick. From the ages of 16-19, she lived a life of seclusion in her home and spend her time studying great Catholic theologians. Over the years the mystic developed a grand following, converted 1,000s to the faith, and advised Popes, Bishops, and Cardinals. She was known for providing spiritual direction and conversions despite enduring long working days and mysterious ills. She died at the age of 33 on April 29, 1380. She is the patron saint of bodily ills, people ridiculed for their piety, the sick, and more. Her feast day is April 29.

GOSPEL: MT 27:11-54 (SHORTEN VERSION)

Jesus stood before the governor, Pontius Pilate, who questioned him, "Are you the king of the Jews?" Jesus said, "You say so." And when he was accused by the chief priests and elders, he made no answer. Then Pilate said to him, "Do you not hear how many things they are testifying against you?" But he did not answer him one word, so that the governor was greatly amazed. Now on the occasion of the feast the governor was accustomed to release to the crowd one prisoner whom they wished. And at that time they had a notorious prisoner called Barabbas. So when they had assembled, Pilate said to them, "Which one do you want me to release to you, Barabbas, or Jesus called Christ?" For he knew that it was out of envy that they had handed him over. While he was still seated on the bench, his wife sent him a message, "Have nothing to do with that righteous man. I suffered much in a dream today because of him." The chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowds to ask for Barabbas but to destroy Jesus. The governor said to them in reply, "Which of the two do you want me to release to you?" They answered, "Barabbas!" Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Jesus called Christ?" They all said, "Let him be crucified!" But he said, "Why? What evil has he done?" They only shouted the louder, "Let him be crucified!" When Pilate saw that he was not succeeding at all, but that a riot was breaking out instead, he took water and washed his hands in the sight of the crowd, saying, "I am innocent of this man's blood. Look to it yourselves." And the whole people said in reply, "His blood be upon us and upon our children." Then he released Barabbas to them, but after he had Jesus scourged, he handed him over to be crucified. Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus inside the praetorium and gathered the whole cohort around him. They stripped off his clothes and threw a scarlet military cloak about him. Weaving a crown out of thorns, they placed it on his head, and a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him, they mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!"
