## FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

APRIL 30, 2023



This weekend marks the Fourth Sunday of Easter. As the hours seem longer and the days feel warmer, Holy Spirit waits in anticipation for its annual celebration — the Parish Summer Festival. If this is your first time hearing about it then it's essential to know that the festival includes a weekend of games, multicultural foods, and entertainment. Our church community consists of English, Spanish, and Vietnamese groups who are responsible for individual tasks to support Holy Spirit. While each group brings its own talents, their collective efforts keep the church alive. These efforts are best seen during our trilingual masses but especially during the festival as the three communities work together to plan a three-day event for over 1,000 people. Despite the differences in culture and language our three communities always come out with a bang so buy your tickets in advance and continue reading on the next page for more information.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

Let's talk about Saint Joseph. While his official feast day is on March 19th, he was given an additional feast day in 1955 by Pope Pius XII. This second feast is celebrated on May 1st and is referred to as the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker. This day is also International Workers Day and demonstrates Joseph as the patron saint of workers. Joseph worked as a carpenter and his fatherhood within the holy family played a huge role in God's plan for the birth and raising of Jesus. Joseph symbolizes the head of the family unit in our Catholic faith and fathers all over the world pray to him for intercession, "In his relationship to Jesus, Joseph was the earthly shadow of the heavenly Father. He watched over him and protected



him, never leaving him to go his own way." (Pope Francis). Pope Francis explains in this letter that Saint Joseph's actions mirrored that of God through his love and protection over Christ. It's important to remember that Joseph, like any parent, had doubts of his own before entering his journey with Mary and scripture proves this in the Book of Matthew. Despite Saint Joseph wanting to divorce Mary in secret, God sent an angel to comfort him, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." (Matthew 1:20-21) This moment and Joseph's decision to say "yes" to God is why we pray to him. His strength and perseverance are what workers and fathers everywhere should aspire to be.

## READINGS

First Reading: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed: "Let the whole house of Israel know for certain that God has made both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and they asked Peter and the other apostles, "What are we to do, my brothers?" Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is made to you and to your children and to all those far off, whomever the Lord our God will call." He testified with many other arguments, and was exhorting them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand persons were added that day.

Second Reading: 1 Pt 2:20b-25

Beloved: If you are patient when you suffer for doing what is good, this is a grace before God. For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example that you should follow in his footsteps. He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth. When he was insulted, he returned no insult; when he suffered, he did not threaten; instead, he handed himself over to the one who judges justly. He himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that, free from sin, we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. For you had gone astray like sheep, but you have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of your souls.

### How to Meditate with Prayer

Meditation engages thought, imagination, emotion, and desire. . . . Christian prayer tries above all to meditate on the mysteries of Christ, as in lectio divina or the rosary. This form of prayerful reflection is of great value, but Christian prayer should go further: to the knowledge of the love of the Lord Jesus, to union with him.

—Catechism of the Catholic Church, nos. 2707-2708

We know about praying the rosary but what about the lectio divina? Spiritual reading of Sacred Scripture, especially the Gospels, is an important form of meditation. This spiritual reading is traditionally called lectio divina or divine reading. Lectio divina is prayer over the Scriptures.

- 1) The first element of this type of prayer is reading (lectio): you take a short passage from the Bible, preferably a Gospel passage and read it carefully, perhaps three or more times. Let it really soak-in.
- 2) The second element is meditation (meditatio). By using your imagination enter into the Biblical scene in order to "see" the setting, the people, and the unfolding action. It is through this meditation that you encounter the text and discover its meaning for your life.
- 3) The next element is prayer (oratio) or your personal response to the text: asking for graces, offering praise or thanksgiving, seeking healing or forgiveness. In this prayerful engagement with the text, you open yourself up to the possibility of contemplation.
- 4) Contemplation (contemplatio) is a gaze turned toward Christ and the things of God. By God's action of grace, you may be raised above meditation to a state of seeing or experiencing the text as mystery and reality. In contemplation, you come into an experiential contact with the One behind and beyond the text. (usccb.org)
