SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

JUNE 11, 2023



We celebrate The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ a.k.a. Corpus Christi this Sunday. Corpus Christi in Latin means "Body of Christ" so we center our attention on the Eucharist's divine influence and purpose. The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the Eucharist as, "the source and summit of the Christian life." (CCC, 1324). This sacrament recharges and gives the fruits of God so that we may live in peace and according to Christ's teachings. In our youth, we find it difficult to imagine how bread and wine transform into Christ. As we develop a profound relationship with God, we start to understand that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. We even see how Eucharistic miracles around the globe are catching the eyes of those who doubt—look at the cases in Bolseno, Italy, and Eten, Peru. The origins of the Eucharist and Blood of Christ stem from the Last Supper from which a bodily sacrifice was made to cleanse the world, "It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship

men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit". (CCC, 1325). The spiritual good of the church is anchored in the body and blood of Christ and is shown in the way we prepare to receive Christ in our bodies through the liturgies and the transubstantiation part of the mass. The church is known as the "Body of Christ" because our goal is to be in communion with God as he desires to be received by his disciples, "Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me." (Jn 6:51-58). This quote is found in the readings for Sunday and highlights Jesus' attempt to explain how by eating his body and drinking his flesh, we become prepared in this life to see him in the next. It is not barbaric but a sign of love. Upon receiving him weekly, we are physically strengthened to combat sin and flee from temptation because the sacraments like the Eucharist help the flesh. Ask a priest, seminarian, bishop, nun, or any devout person of faith and they will tell you the wonderous feeling of certainty that is God's presence. Who in your life would give their body to save yours? Son of God let us always be in a state of grace so that we may welcome you every Sunday into our bodies and hearts.

Celebramos la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, también conocido como Corpus Christi este domingo. Corpus Christi en latín significa "Cuerpo de Cristo", por lo que centramos nuestra atención en la influencia y el propósito divinos de la Eucaristía. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica describe la Eucaristía como "la fuente y cumbre de la vida cristiana". (CIC, 1324). Este sacramento recarga y da los frutos de Dios para que vivamos en paz y según las enseñanzas de Cristo. En nuestra juventud, nos cuesta imaginar cómo el pan y el vino se transforman en Cristo. A medida que desarrollamos una relación profunda con Dios, empezamos a comprender que Jesús está realmente presente en la Eucaristía. Incluso vemos cómo los milagros eucarísticos en todo el mundo están llamando la atención de aquellos que dudan: mire los casos en Bolseno, Italia y Eten, Perú. Los orígenes de la Eucaristía y de la Sangre de Cristo se derivan de la Última Cena de la que surge una se hizo el sacrificio para limpiar el mundo, "Es la culminación tanto de la acción de Dios santificando el mundo en Cristo como del culto que los hombres ofrecen a Cristo y por él al Padre en el Espíritu Santo". (CIC, 1325).

El bien espiritual de la iglesia está anclado en el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo y se muestra en la forma en que nos preparamos para recibir a Cristo en nuestros cuerpos a través de las liturgias y la parte de la transubstanciación de la misa. La iglesia es conocida como el "Cuerpo de Cristo" porque nuestra meta es estar en comunión con Dios ya que él desea ser recibido por sus discípulos, "Así como el Padre vivo me envió y yo tengo vida por el Padre, así también el que se alimenta de mí tendrá vida gracias a mí". (Jn 6, 51-58). Esta cita se encuentra en las lecturas del domingo y destaca el intento de Jesús de explicar cómo al comer su cuerpo y beber su carne, nos preparamos en esta vida para verlo en la próxima. No es una barbaridad sino una muestra de amor. Al recibirla semanalmente, somos fortalecidos físicamente para combatir el pecado y huir de la tentación porque los sacramentos como la Eucaristía ayudan a la carne. Pregúntale a un sacerdote, seminarista, obispo, monja o cualquier persona devota de fe y te dirán el maravilloso sentimiento de certeza que es la presencia de Dios. ¿Quién en tu vida daría su cuerpo para salvar el tuyo? Hijo de Dios, déjanos estar siempre en estado de gracia para que podamos recibirtre cada domingo en nuestros cuerpos y corazones.



SAINT OF THE WEEK/ SANTO DE LA SEMANA

Let us read about Saint Anthony of Padua, priest, and doctor of the church whose feast day is June 13. "His journey as the servant of God began as a very young man when he decided to join the Augustinians in Lisbon, giving up a future of wealth and power to be a servant of God. Later when the bodies of the first Franciscan martyrs went through the Portuguese city where he was stationed, he was again filled with an intense longing to be one of those closest to Jesus himself: those who die for the Good News. Recognized as a great man of prayer and a great Scripture and theology scholar, Anthony became the first friar to teach theology to the other friars. Soon he was called from that post to preach to the Albigensians in France, using his profound knowledge of Scripture and theology to convert and reassure those who had been misled by their denial of Christ's divinity and of the sacraments. After he led the friars in northern Italy for three years, he made his headquarters in the city of Padua. He resumed his preaching and began writing sermon notes to help other preachers. In the spring of 1231 Anthony withdrew to a friary at Camposampiero where he had a sort of treehouse built as a hermitage. There he prayed and prepared for death. On June 13, he became very ill and asked to be taken back to Padua, where he died after receiving the last sacraments. Anthony was canonized less than a year later and named a Doctor of the Church in 1946." Read more: bit.ly/franciscanmedia.

Leamos sobre San Antonio de Padua, presbítero y doctor de la iglesia cuya fiesta es el 13 de junio. "Su camino como siervo de Dios comenzó siendo muy joven cuando decidió unirse a los agustinos en Lisboa, abandonando una futura de riquezas y poder para ser un siervo de Dios. Más tarde, cuando los cuerpos de los primeros mártires franciscanos pasaron por la ciudad portuguesa donde estaba destinado, lo invadió de nuevo un intenso anhelo de ser uno de los más cercanos al mismo Jesús: esos que mueren por la Buena Nueva Reconocido como un gran hombre de oración y un gran estudiado de las Escrituras y la teología, Antonio se convirtió en el primer fraile en enseñar teología a los demás frailes. Pronto fue llamado de ese puesto para predicar a los albigenses en Francia, utilizando su profundo conocimiento de las Escrituras y la teología para convertir y tranquilizar a aquellos que habían sido engañados por su negación de la divinidad de Cristo y de los sacramentos. Después de dirigir a los frailes en el norte de Italia durante tres años, estableció su cuartel general en la ciudad de Padua. Reanudó su predicción y comenzó a escribir notas de sermones para ayudar a otros predicadores. En la primavera de 1231, Antonio se retiró a un convento en Camposampiero, donde hizo construir una especie de casa en un árbol a modo de ermita. Allí oró y se preparó para la muerte. El 13 de junio enfermó gravemente y pidió que lo llevaran de regreso a Padua, donde murió después de recibir los últimos sacramentos. Anthony fue canonizado menos de un año después y nombrado Doctor de la Iglesia en 1946". Lea más: bit.ly/franciscanmedia.

WHY ARE WE PRAYING IN REPARATION?

Lepanto's reports reveal that the AUSCP undermines the Catholic Faith by:

- Allowing material promoting same-sex "marriage" to be distributed at AUSCP events
- Supporting the adoption of children by homosexuals and lesbians
- Honoring "champions" of LGBTQ activism at AUSCP assemblies
- Providing a platform to pro-LGBT speakers at AUSCP assemblies
- Promoting "glittery" protests in support of drag queens
- Supporting the sacramental ordination of women
- Complaining to create priestless parishes run by deacons.

The latest initiative from the AUSCP is an even greater threat to the Church. This month the AUSCP issued a statement to be voted on at the Annual Assembly. If it is passed, the AUSCP will circulate it to the press and the United States Conference of Bishops (USCB). This statement will pressure the bishops to:

- Admit men with homosexual attractions to formation and sacramental ordination.
- Give "internal affirmation" to already ordained homosexuals.
- Call for the "ongoing development" of Church teaching concerning sexuality, in light of modern advances in the sciences.

Clearly, the AUSCP has forgotten (or chosen to ignore) St. Paul's dire warning:

"Do not ever neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor the effeminate, nor liars with mankind... shall possess the kingdom of God." 1 Cor 6:9-10
