TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

JUNE 25, 2023



This Sunday marks the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time and in the Gospel, for today we learn about the necessity of proclaiming the faith openly. As the 12 Apostles listened to Jesus speak, they heeded these words, "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father." (Mt 10:26-33). As people of faith, we are called to not only live the teachings of Christ within our Christian communities but also to share our knowledge and be an example. When asked, "Who are you?" you answer with confidence, "I am Catholic!" When others ask what you believe, you mold your words to match the teachings of Christ for they come from God the Father. If we deny Christ on earth, what makes us worthy to enter the kingdom of God at our death?

The Apostles devoted their lives to delivering the news of Christ, leading to the expansion of Christianity, Peter the Apostle becoming the first Pope in 30 AD, and the early formation of the Catholic Church. Preaching the faith in today's social climate is not the same as preaching to crowds because we have a more potent tool at hand — the virality of the internet. Apps like Instagram, TikTok, or Twitter allow us to freely express our religious beliefs but it is also a playground for disrespect and bullying. Cancel culture hunts for people who do not agree with trendy normalities from hookup culture to gender ideologies in elementary schools so Catholics fear the idea of posting anything remotely related to their faith. When we are plagued with the fear of judgment we must follow in the footsteps of the Apostles, "Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows." (Mt). If God knows what happens to all animals then we should not worry about ourselves. Use the internet and your voice to respectfully and mercifully proclaim the faith as Jesus did. Find strength in the Holy Spirit to acknowledge Christ all the days of your life.

Este domingo marca el Duodécimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario y del Evangelio, pues hoy aprendemos sobre la necesidad de proclamar abiertamente la fe. Mientras los 12 Apóstoles escuchaban a Jesús hablar, prestaron atención a estas palabras: "Todo el que me reconozca ante los demás, yo lo reconoceré ante mi Padre celestial. Pero al que me niegue delante de los demás, yo lo negaré delante de mi Padre celestial". (Mt 10, 26-33). Como personas de fe, estamos llamados no solo a vivir las enseñanzas de Cristo dentro de nuestras comunidades cristianas, sino también a compartir nuestro conocimiento y ser un ejemplo. Cuando se le preguntó, «¿Quién es usted?» usted responde con confianza: "¡Soy católico!" Cuando otros te preguntan en qué crees, moldeas tus palabras para que coincidan con las enseñanzas de Cristo porque provienen de Dios Padre. Si negamos a Cristo en la tierra, ¿qué nos hace dignos de entrar en el reino de Dios en el momento de nuestra muerte? Los Apóstoles dedicaron sus vidas a dar la noticia de Cristo, lo que condujo a la expansión del cristianismo, el Apóstol Pedro se convirtió en el primer Papa en el año 30 dC y la formación temprana de la Iglesia Católica. Predicar la fe en el clima social actual no es lo mismo que predicar a multitudes porque tenemos a mano una herramienta más potente: la viralidad de Internet. Aplicaciones como Instagram, TikTok o Twitter nos permiten expresar libremente nuestras creencias religiosas, pero también son un campo de juego para la falta de respeto y el acoso. Cancelar la cultura busca personas que no estén de acuerdo con las normalidades de moda, desde la cultura de las conexiones hasta las ideologías de género en las escuelas primarias, por lo que los católicos temen la idea de publicar cualquier cosa remotamente relacionada con su fe. Cuando estamos plagados de temor al juicio, debemos seguir los pasos de los Apóstoles: "Hasta todos los cabellos de vuestra cabeza están contados. Así que no tengas miedo; vales más que muchos pájaros. (Monte). Si Dios sabe lo que les sucede a todos los animales, entonces no debemos preocuparnos por nosotros mismos. Usa Internet y tu voz para proclamar la fe con respeto y misericordia como lo hizo Jesús. Encuentra fuerza en el Espíritu Santo para reconocer a Cristo todos los días de tu vida.

SAINT OF THE WEEK/ SANTO DE LA SEMANA

Let us read about Saint Cyril of Alexandria – feast day June 27th. "An Egyptian bishop and theologian, he is best known for his role in the Council of Ephesus, where the Church confirmed that Christ is both God and man in one person. Cyril was most likely born in Alexandria, the metropolis of ancient Egypt, between 370 and 380. From his writings, it appears he received a solid literary and theological education. Along with his uncle, Patriarch Theophilus of Alexandria, he played a role in an early fifth-century dispute between the Egyptian and Greek churches. There is evidence he may have been a monk before becoming a bishop. When Theophilus died in 412, Cyril was chosen to succeed him at the head of the Egyptian Church. He continued his uncle's policy of insisting on Alexandria's preeminence within the Church over Constantinople, despite the political prominence of the imperial capital." Leamos sobre San Cirilo de Alejandría – fiesta el 27 de junio. "Obispo y teólogo egipcio, es más conocido por su papel en el Concilio de Éfeso, donde la Iglesia confirmó que Cristo es tanto Dios como hombre en una sola persona. Lo más probable es que Cirilo nació en Alejandría, la metrópoli del antiguo Egipto, entre 370 y 380. A partir de sus escritos, parece que recibió una sólida educación literaria y teológica. Junto con su tío, el patriarca Teófilo de Alejandría, desempeñó un papel en una disputa de principios del siglo V entre las iglesias egipcia y griega. Hay pruebas pudo haber sido monje antes de convertirse en obispo. Cuando Teófilo murió en 412, Cirilo fue elegido para sucederlo al frente de la Iglesia egipcia. Continuó la política de su tío de insistir en la preeminencia de Alejandría dentro de la Iglesia sobre Constantinopla, a pesar de la política prominencia de la capital imperial". 
