
*O Holy Spirit, beloved of my soul, I adore You.

REFLECT THROUGH THE GOSPEL

This weekend marks the Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the Gospel of Matthew, we read about an obscure wedding feast where those invited did not attend and those least expected arrived. Jesus uses this parable to describe how the kingdom of heaven will be like a wedding feast hosted by a king. The king sent out invitations to the elite but they did not show and instead, he invited anyone—good or evil as the scripture states. For someone of low class such as a beggar, servant, or prostitute to be invited to a celebration as honored as the prince's wedding is not common since only a few are chosen. The king in this story represents God and the feast is his kingdom. The invitations also can symbolize the method in which the Catholic Church welcomes everyone no matter their circumstances or past. Everyone is invited to the feast of the mass because the kingdom of God is within the grasp of whoever, by their free will, wants it. God is always present in the mass, in prayer, and in everything that reflects good. Jesus also says, "Many are invited, but few are chosen." This is to mean that while a community of faith opens its doors, there is no guarantee everyone inside will be pleasing in God's eyes and be permitted entrance into the kingdom. This is demonstrated through the guest who was not dressed in wedding garments. He did not come dressed for the occasion and was kicked out which is to say he did not prepare for the kingdom of God. This parable reminds us all that while we may be within the walls of the church, we must live according to God's will in every aspect of our lives. In doing so, we are preparing our souls to be the few that are chosen to enter and stay in God's kingdom.



Mt 22:1-14

Este fin de semana se celebra el Vigésimo Octavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. En el Evangelio de Mateo leemos acerca de una oscura fiesta de bodas a la que los invitados no asistieron y llegaron los menos esperados. Jesús usa esta parábola para describir cómo el reino de los cielos será como un banquete de bodas organizado por un rey. El rey envió invitaciones a la élite, pero no aparecieron y, en cambio, invitó a cualquiera, bueno o malo, como dice la Escritura. Que alguien de clase baja como un mendigo, un sirviente o una prostituta sea invitado a una celebración tan honorable como la boda del príncipe no es común ya que solo se eligen unos pocos. El rey en esta historia representa a Dios y la fiesta es su reino. Las invitaciones también pueden simbolizar el método con el que la Iglesia Católica da la bienvenida a todos, sin importar sus circunstancias o pasado. Todos están invitados a la fiesta de la misa porque el reino de Dios está al alcance de quien, por su libre albedrío, lo desee. Dios está siempre presente en la misa, en la oración y en todo lo que refleja el bien. Jesús también dice: "Muchos son los invitados, pero pocos los elegidos". Esto quiere decir que si bien una comunidad de fe abre sus puertas, no hay garantía de que todos los que están dentro sean agradables a los ojos de Dios y se les permita la entrada al reino. Esto se demuestra a través del invitado que no estaba vestido con traje de boda. No vino vestido para la ocasión y fue expulsado, es decir, no se preparó para el reino de Dios. Esta parábola nos recuerda a todos que si bien estemos dentro de los muros de la iglesia, debemos vivir de acuerdo con la voluntad de Dios en cada aspecto de nuestras vidas. Al hacerlo, estamos preparando nuestras almas para ser los pocos elegidos para entrar y permanecer en el reino de Dios.
