

This Sunday marks the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the Gospel of Matthew, we read about the recruitment of Simon (Peter), Andrew, James, and John. Jesus was on a mission to build the kingdom but he needed help by way of his apostles—messengers sent to spread the gospel. You can think of the 12 Apostles like Marvel's Avengers. They were real life superheroes spreading the teachings of Christ and that the kingdom of heaven was at hand. They cured many people of their illnesses and from their attachment to sin. His soldiers were different than what we would expect the son of man to select. Simon and his brother Andrew were fishermen along with James and his brother John. They were simple working men who encountered the Messiah and chose to leave everything to follow him. It was this decision that changed their fates and would later influence the spread of Christianity and the institution of the Catholic Church as we know it. The apostles are an example of God's power in using individuals to create good in the world. Humility and the desire to put others first before yourself is the key to doing God's will. There are no special requirements such as money or power to follow Christ, you simply must have the desire to do it and rejoice in the path he leads you on. In what ways is God calling you to follow him? How does your uniqueness help spread his love? Fishermen, the old, and the young are all called to great things no matter our background.
