Abortion in America

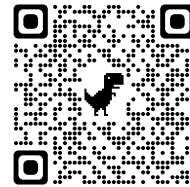
On Saturday, January 13, 2024, the annual San Diego Walk for Life was held in Waterfront Park. The view of the ocean was accompanied by a crowd of thousands visiting various booths with resources for mothers and children. The crowd then formed into a march around the park with people holding balloons, rosaries, and signs reading everything from “Pray to End Abortion” to “Pray to End Rape”. People of all ages and religions attended with wide smiles as cars passed by honking in support. “It looks like there is a lot more people this year!” said a Walk For Life participant as she held her 2-and-a-half-month-old son in her arms, while accompanied by her husband and friends. Seeing the variety of ages walking to end abortion in America is a testament to how strong the pro-life community is. Pro-life means to defend human life from conception to natural death meaning one should not discriminate life based on any circumstances. All human life is precious and it is our job to defend the most vulnerable in society. Roe v. Wade is an example of what it means to dispose of the dignity of human life. When it was overturned in June 2022, a beacon of hope was felt in the hearts of many who were lied to about the true after effects of their decisions. The overturning of this 1973 Supreme Court decision also meant that abortion would remain legal depending on which state you live in. In California anyone, “who is pregnant has a legal right to choose to have an abortion before viability”(Abortion.ca.gov). Viability is when a baby can survive outside the uterus and medical viability is generally considered between 23-24 weeks. This means that a women can legally choose to end her pregnancy even at 5 months for whatever reason. By 5 months a mother can begin to feel movement in her womb and some of the baby’s vital organs have begun or finished forming. This is why Catholics and non-religious individuals believe that abortion is wrong no matter the stage— yes that means even at conception. A 2021 science journal, “The Scientific Consensus on When a Human’s Life Begins” concluded that, “Biologists from 1,058 academic institutions around the world assessed survey items on when a human’s life begins and, overall, 96% (5337 out of 5577) affirmed the fertilization view.” This journal defined the fertilization view as the view that life begins at fertilization also known as conception. As Catholics we are taught that life begins at conception because God created each of us with a purpose. Life is given and taken from God which is why our sixth commandment forbids killing and abortion is defined as the intentional ending of human life. It’s amazing to see how our faith mirrors science and even at times man’s law.
