Divine Mercy Sunday at Holy Spirit

Sunday April 7, 2024, is Divine Mercy Sunday. Holy Spirit will have an Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament following the Divine Mercy Chaplet in three languages (English, Spanish, and Vietnamese). As many of you know, this day is filled with many graces and they are noted in Saint Faustina's Diary. During one of her encounters with Jesus, our Lord said, "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners" (Diary, no. 699). Her experiences were later examined by the Vatican and on May 5, 2000 they instituted the Sunday after Easter as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. A plenary indulgence can be granted when completing a list of requirements. Last week's bulletin included that list and a copy is found below. Have a blessed Divine Mercy Sunday!

Requirements for Plenary Indulgence for Divine Mercy Sunday

The extraordinary graces promised to the faithful by our Lord Himself through St. Faustina should not be confused with the plenary indulgence granted by Pope John Paul II for the devout observance of the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday). The Decree of the Holy See offers: "A plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who. in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!)..."

Sick or Homebound?

Try to arrange for a Eucharistic Minister to bring you Communion. Parishes should arrange for Eucharistic Ministers to visit the homebound and bring them the Eucharist and, if possible, literature on Divine Mercy Sunday, Chaplet prayer cards, and rosaries. If a visit is not possible, however, you can still participate in the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday by making a Spiritual Communion with great trust (See page 2). God will give you all the graces that He sees that you need because of your great trust. You also can see the celebration of Holy Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday on EWTN (check your TV listing). The Act of Spiritual Communion will be recited at that time
