Happy Fathers Day

As I was scrolling through social media, I came upon a video that left an impression on me. The topic was on the purpose of men and women and the roles each play in the Sacrament of Marriage. The person in the video explained how, "A woman is expected to give her body while a man gives his life." This statement holds strong truths by highlighting unique and equally important duties of the opposite sex. A mother's body changes to grow new life, endures labor pains, and experiences physical or emotional effects postpartum. A father experiences no physical changes to his body except depending on what he ate that day. Women sacrifice by creating life and men were created to protect it. Protection can be achieved by nurturing that life to fulfill its utmost potential in God's eyes. Fathers provide wisdom, leadership, and are expected to lay down their lives for the safety of their family, "Love to be real, it must cost—it must hurt—it must empty us of self." (St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta). A father says no to his needs so he can place his families before his own. In doing so he places a higher importance to them and gives his struggles to God so that the Lord may strengthen him just as Saint Joseph uplifted and protected Mother Mary. Saint John Paul II emphasizes the duty of men as to, "ensure the harmonious and united development of all the members of the family." This can also mean that a father's actions bear significant weight because they can directly impact the collective by the standard he sets. 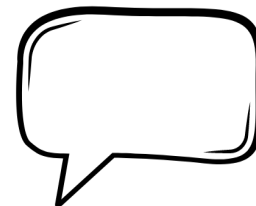

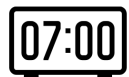
