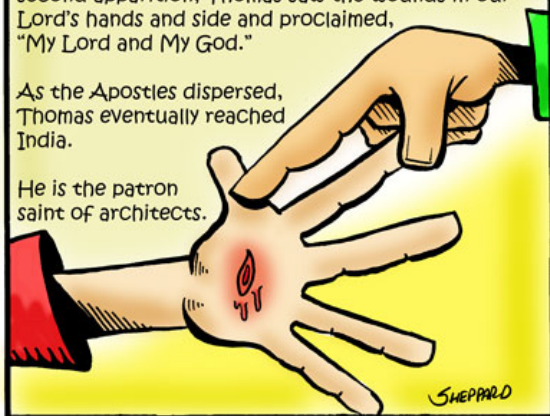
SAINTS FUN FACTS

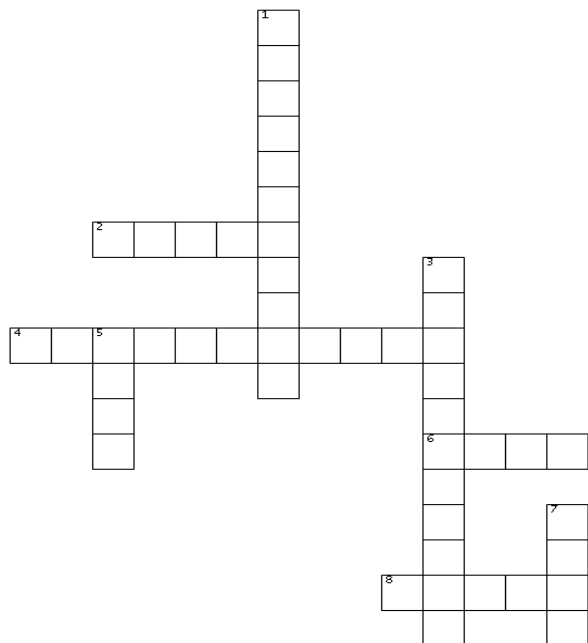
